Action Phrases (Senior)

- Discovered critical elements of DM pathway messaging
- Developed selective antagonists for DM-3 receptor
- Demonstrated DM blockade activates Penfold suppression
- Identified orphan drugs with DM blockade activity

Action Phrases (Earlier Career)

- Characterized behavioral and neural aspects of aberrant sensation and perception with a focus on the somatosensory system.
- Conducted studies of white matter organization in individuals with autism spectrum disorder and other developmental delays using diffusion tensor imaging.

Summary Sentences

- Proven causes of miscarriage are elusive.
- Sophisticated exposure measures are required.
- Population-based cohorts are superior to clinical cohorts
- Gene-by-environment work in consortia is a promising approach.

Miscellaneous Advice

- Separate work from that of mentor (my idea & implementation)
- Have at least 3 categories
- Subdivide if you have more than 4 papers per category and are leaving out “group-able” items.
