

# 2024 VANDERBILT EDGE FOR SCHOLARS REVIEW

The Edge for Scholars at Vanderbilt offers an internal review by senior faculty of any R application—first or second R given priority—and any K application, as well as other funding mechanisms such as VA Merit/CDA, AHA, etc. (VFRS applications cannot be accepted for review.)

Submissions may include resubmissions, revisions and renewals for basic, translational, and clinical investigation for the corresponding NIH cycle.

## INSTRUCTIONS

1. **Identify** the NIH submission date and corresponding **Vanderbilt due dates** in the chart below.
2. Fill out a [Survey of Intent](#) and complete it by the corresponding due date. You will need your draft abstract, specific aims page and current NIH biosketch (drafts are used to help match to reviewers and not distributed).
3. Email a **\*SINGLE PDF\*** of below listed **Grant Materials** by the corresponding due date to [rebecca.helton@vumc.org](mailto:rebecca.helton@vumc.org).

**What to Include: The bare minimum requirements are noted below. All other documents are strongly encouraged in order to receive the most thorough review possible.**

- i. Cover letter – can be to us or your NIH institute
- ii. Project Summary/Abstract (~30 lines)
- iii. Summary Statement if revision/resubmission
- iv. Your response if revision/resubmission
- v. **REQUIRED:** Specific Aims – single page
- vi. **REQUIRED:** Research Strategy – note/highlight your responses if revision/resubmission
- vii. References cited
- viii. Facilities and resources
- ix. [PHS Human Subjects and Clinical Trials Information Attachments](#) (if applicable)
- x. **REQUIRED:** Key personnel and NIH biosketches
- xi. Letters of support – include what you have/drafts okay
- xii. Budget – include what you have
- xiii. **REQUIRED:** If K-award: must include career development and RCR training plans
- xiv. If non-NIH or new NIH grant type (i.e., R35): include copy of RFA

*\*Please note: We cannot compile grants.*

### DON'T FORGET:

- a. Use the NIH format required for your application
- b. Include as much information as you can to ensure you receive the most comprehensive review. We understand some items may not be ready at the time of review.

**All materials are due by 5:00 PM Central Time on the corresponding due date.  
No late submissions accepted.**

## WHAT TO EXPECT

You will receive an individual video recording link and reviewers' written critiques within a few days of the review, giving you time to respond to recommendations before it's time to submit to the NIH. **You are strongly encouraged to watch the video with your mentor. (AIDS reviews are not videotaped)**
