Mentor Database: Introduction



- Flight Tracker databases are <u>mentee</u> databases
- At Vanderbilt, we've had discussion for some time about organizing a <u>mentor</u> database
- Our CTSA renewal has added some urgency to this as it would help us collect data for Table 2 and report to the NIH
- This is all very prospective \rightarrow a trial balloon



Mentor Database: Key Components



- Same automated grants and publications download
- Custom survey to handle NIH reporting outcomes
- Ability to match expertise from mentor to prospective mentee
- Interaction with (forthcoming) Mentor Agreements
- Auto-populate list of mentors from mentors in Flight Tracker
