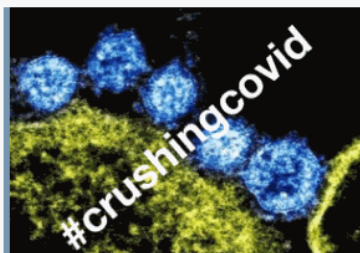

Abstracts from ExPORTER/PubMed



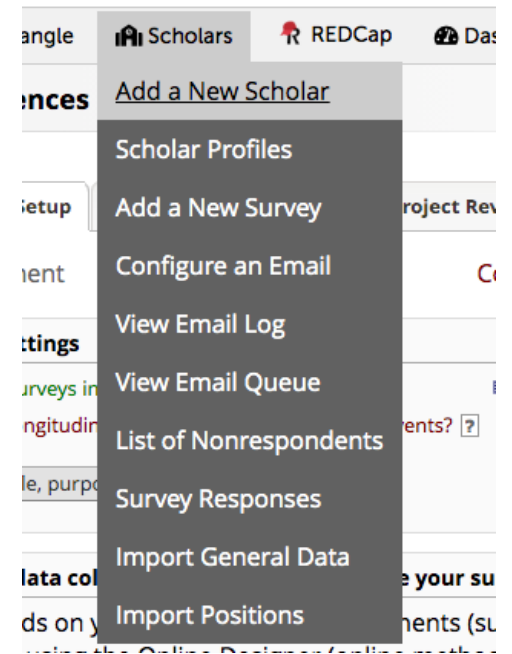
- Data request for analysis of a group of scholars by keywords
- Searched grant/publication titles → Want to search abstracts
- Fortunately, NIH ExPORTER/RePORTER and PubMed has both
- New fields in REDCap (2.30.0) & automatically downloaded



Email Queue



- See which emails are scheduled to go out.
- Already have an email generator and an email log.



Bibliometrics Download



- Need to keep up to date.
- Issue: Rate-limiters on API download
 - 3 per second per multiple PMIDs – PubMed
 - 1 per second per one PMID – Altmetrics
- Was running one day per month (18th)
→ At Vanderbilt, lasted well into afternoon
- Now, space out throughout each day of the month (only a sample)
- Still updated once a month
- Working on (free?) API key support from Altmetrics



Veterans Administration



- Academic medical centers and VAs have historically had close associations (VA CDAs, research projects, etc.)
- We recently realized that we were not searching through the “Veterans Health Administration” on PubMed or the RePORTER systems.



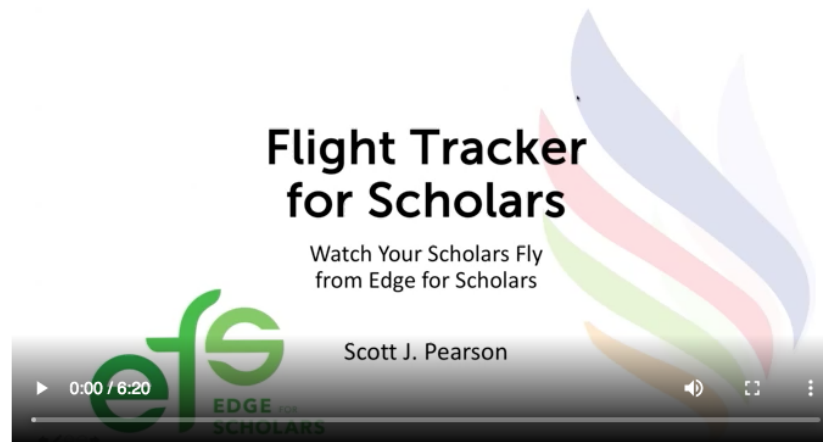
- Added it alongside a match on the city to Federal RePORTER, NIH ExPORTER, and PubMed sweeps.
 - Match by name, institution, and (in case of VA) city

Applicant Pool Trial Balloons

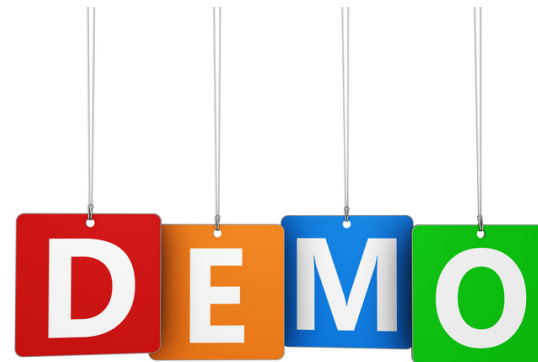


- Training grant applicants
