What's New?

Fallout from Federal RePORTER



- Federal RePORTER turned off
- This created **millions** of log statements in REDCap in March.
- Flight Tracker maintains logs for one month.
- When it tries to clean this up at midnight, the database increases its time **exponentially**.
 - 10,000 rows - 1 second
 - 50,000 rows - 8 seconds
 - Millions? Locked
- **Cron can stop entirely (e.g., Indiana CTSA).**
- Fix: Repeating deletes in smaller chunks. Out in **4.8.2**, this Friday.



Public Access Compliance



- Federal Public Access Policy
- Under **Pubs** → **Public Access Compliance**
- Feedback:
 - Pre-written email to scholar.
 - Download as a CSV.
 - Show more scholars per page (10 → 50).
 - Search all scholars by grant number.
- **Now completed in 4.8.0**

Public Access Compliance Update

Compliance Threshold: 02-03-2022

This only affects publications already included in the [Publication Wrangler](#).
Publications earlier than 04-01-2008 will be disregarded since the NIH Manuscript System only started on this date.

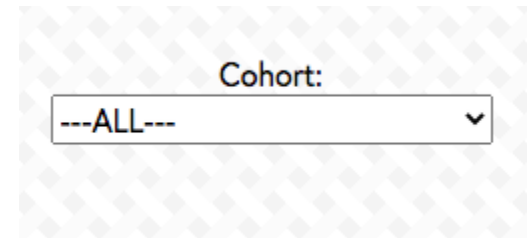

Using Flight Tracker Cohorts



- **Defined: Sub-Group**
- Original idea – a group tracked over time
- Available all over Flight Tracker
- Allows you to look at smaller partitions like:
 - MDs vs. PhDs vs. MD/PhDs
 - Women, Women MDs, Women PhDs
 - Under-Represented Minorities
 - Those who hold certain grants
 - Classes of graduates in a training program
 - Etc.

Adding a Cohort



- Based on a trait or group of traits
- Up to 15 filters to describe traits
- Boolean logic to combine (AND/OR/XOR)
- Dynamically updated
 - When the data change, the cohort changes!

Create a FT Cohort Project



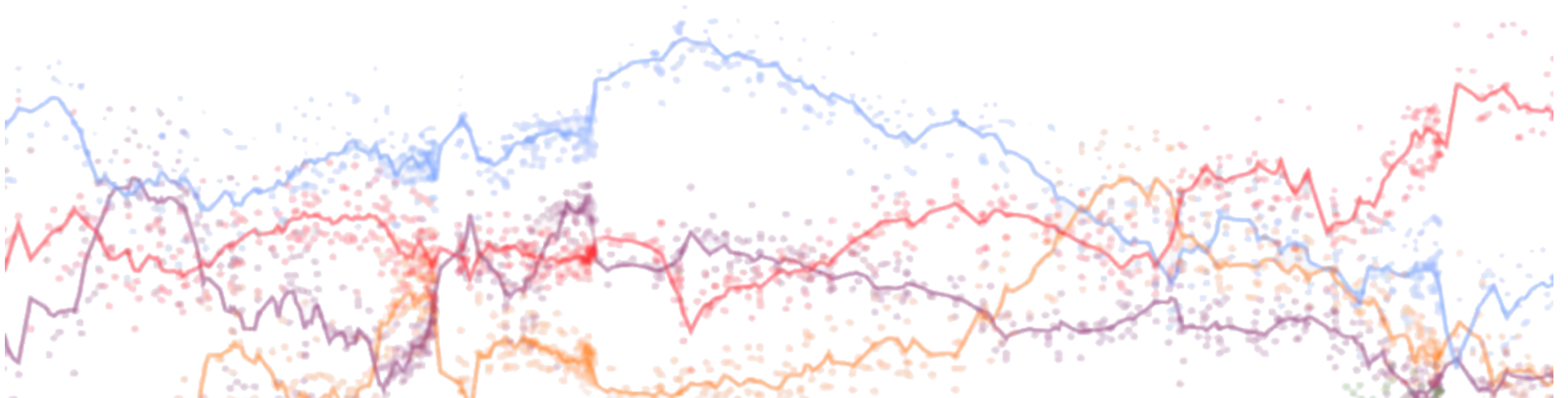
- A **read-only** copy of one cohort's data

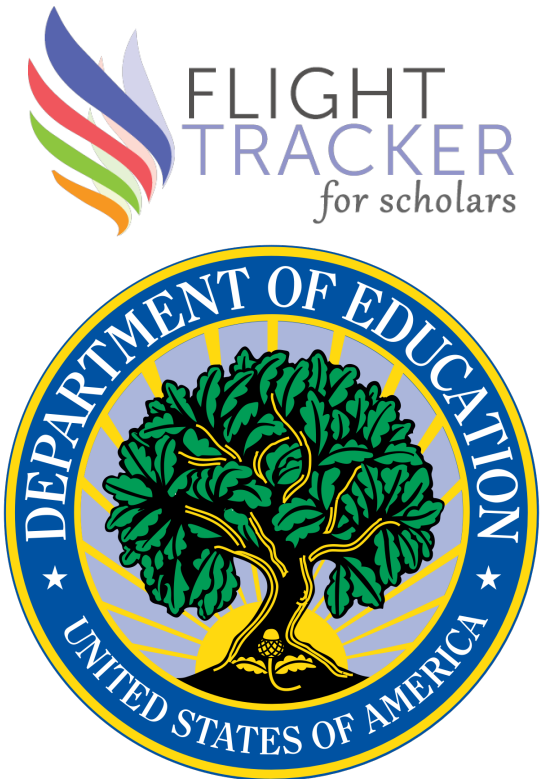
Downloading from NSF

- Because Federal RePORTER gone
- NSF has API for grants
- Lower volume
- Currently working through issues to make smooth
 - CAREER Awards = K Equivalent
 - REU Sites = Training Grant Admin
 - Other grants = R01 Equivalents
- Out in **4.9.0** (next week?)



Downloading from Dept. of Ed.

- Looking into Institute of Educational Sciences' grant API (IES) and ERIC (Education's PubMed)
 - Because Federal RePORTER gone
 - Education pubs and grants
- Benefits
 - CTSA's usually have an educational component
 - Also, expands scope of Flight Tracker into education
 - Plugs into existing FT processes
- Slow timescale – in several months



Mentee-Mentor Agreements

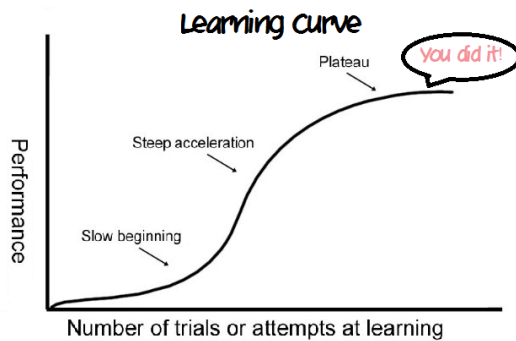
