## What's New?

#### **SSL Errors**

- Email errors related to "SSL" might have occurred in recent versions
- Turned off a check to verify that a REDCap server has a secure certificate
- Makes calls to external websites (via APIs) a little less secure, but not major since we are using public data (no personal health information)
- Avoids headaches with REDCap admins
- Implemented in v5.7.11 and higher





#### **Cron Completion Errors**



- A couple of groups have reported that their crons aren't completing
- My first hypothesis as to the problem was invalidated today
- Elizabeth Palambo of WashU and David Surber of Wisconsin-Madison are my debugging data points
- Elizabeth and I are hoping to follow up on a new hypothesis tomorrow or Friday

#### **Methods of Collection**



#### What You're (Probably) Collecting

- Job(s) after graduation/end of training
- Grants after training

#### Ways to Do It

- Surveying or asking scholars
- Google + manual entry
- Flight Tracker's grant tracking

#### **Collecting Info from Scholars**



- Saves you searching
- Ensures accuracy (most of the time)
- May collect things you miss (e.g., foundation grants at another institution)



#### **Collecting Info from Scholars**



#### **Best Practices (From Experience)**

- Survey regularly
- Ask for info on their next job and a permanent/ personal email address before they leave
- If they're on your grant, ask for their final progress report before they go

# Finding Missing Scholars: Searching



- LinkedIn is usually the most up to date
  - You can sign up for Premium to gain the ability to email anyone via the site (InMail) - \$30/month
- Googling the name and your institution can often pull up a faculty page at their next institution b/c it lists their degrees

### Finding Missing Scholars: PubMed



- Search their name and a relevant scientific term in PubMed
- Or just search the name if unique enough
- Since 2014, all authors list affiliations in PubMed
- If they're the corresponding author, viewing the article at the journal will give you an email address



#### **Finding Missing Scholars**



Can't find the email address? Once you know the institution, you can often find an email address for *someone* there, then use that format.

(This doesn't always work.)



#### **Finding Missing Scholars**



#### Once you've found someone...

- Ask them to take a survey or
- Ask for their CV (this can get better response from those with more years out from your program)
- Put in as much data as you can yourself so they have less to type

#### **Position Change**



- Tracks scholar's jobs before and after they're with you
- Feeds Table 8
- Institution names are added to list to search PubMed, NIH RePORTER, etc.




