What's New?

New Altmetric Fields



- Added about 27 bibliometric fields to Citation form
- Automatically updated throughout a month
- More metrics about a publication
 - Rankings of mentions for journal and for entire Altmetric database
 - Counts of mentions in news sources, Reddit, YouTube, Patents, Wikipedia & more

- General menu → Configure Application
- If turned on, sends out an email of recently downloaded grants & publications
- Frequency: Weekly v. Monthly
- Scope: All Scholars v. Current v. Current/Recent (5 years)

Improved Data Dictionary Update Process



- Long-standing issues with updating the Data Dictionary on the Flight Tracker Home page
- **v5.12.2** contains a new, simpler algorithm that (I hope) is less prone to buggy issues
- Nothing appears different... except that it hopefully works better!

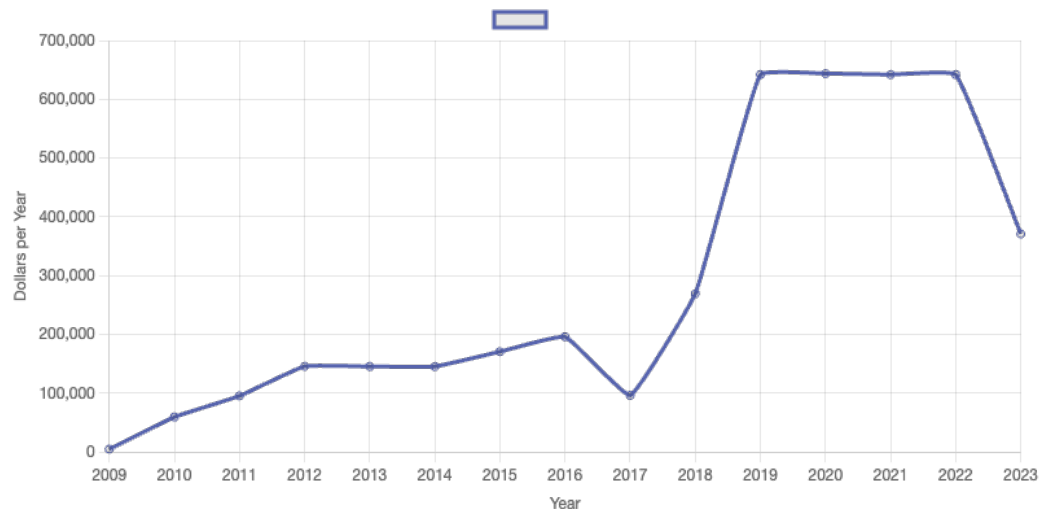

Scholar Grant Funding over Time

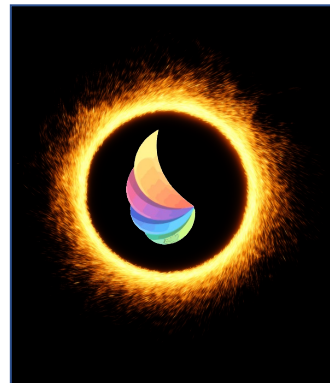


- Reported Grant Funding (Total Dollars)

- Scholars menu → Scholar Profiles

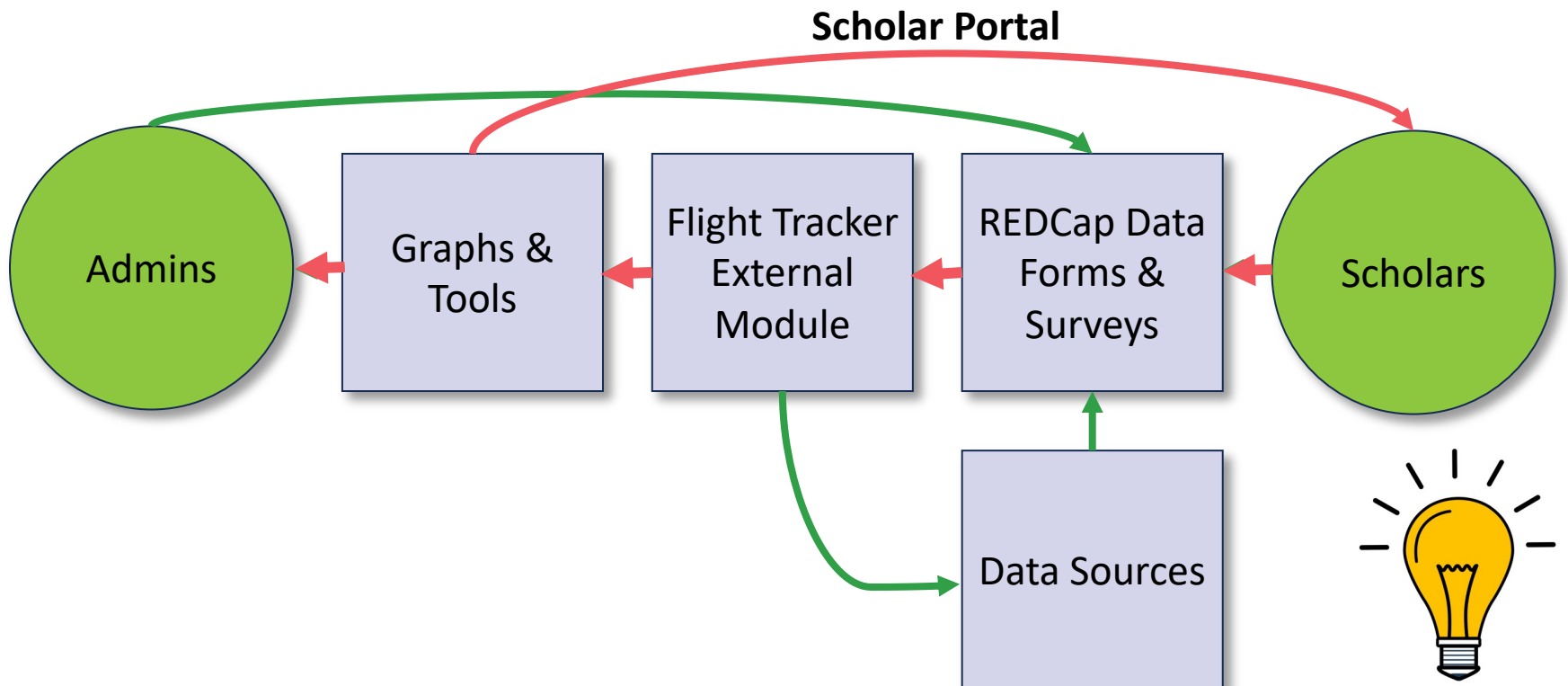

One Link Accesses Many Projects



- Scholars access page via a REDCap login (required)
- Do NOT need REDCap User Rights
- If someone is in **multiple** Flight Trackers, they can access data from **multiple** projects
- Siloed: Cannot access others' data

Match to Flight Tracker Projects



- Again, requires that scholars have REDCap access
- Matched to projects by name or user-id
- **Warning:** Name-matching is imprecise
 - We'll handle issues as they arise with this. Be in touch!
- To start, select a project. If only one project matches, it'll select that one automatically. If none match, a friendly message is given.

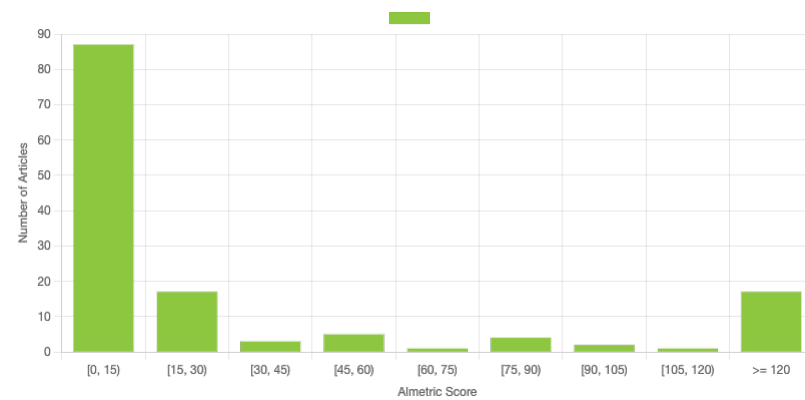
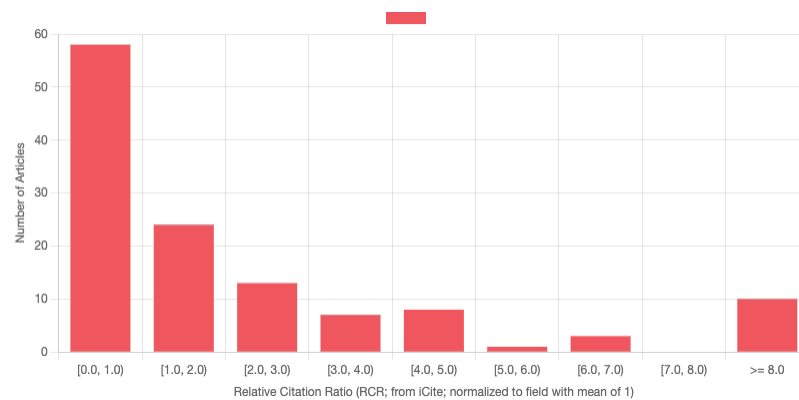

Publishing Impact



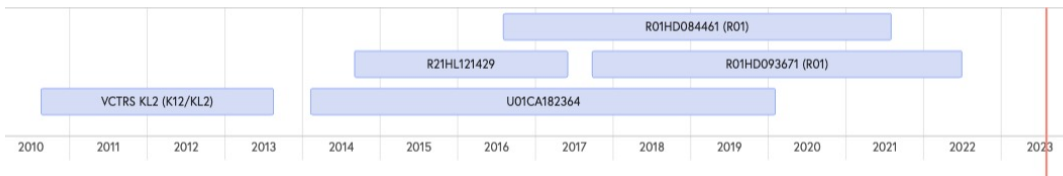
- Graph of publication impact factors only for your scholar
- Same as group images, only restricted to one scholar
- Relative Citation Ratios (red) and Altmetric Scores (green)



Grant & Publication Timelines



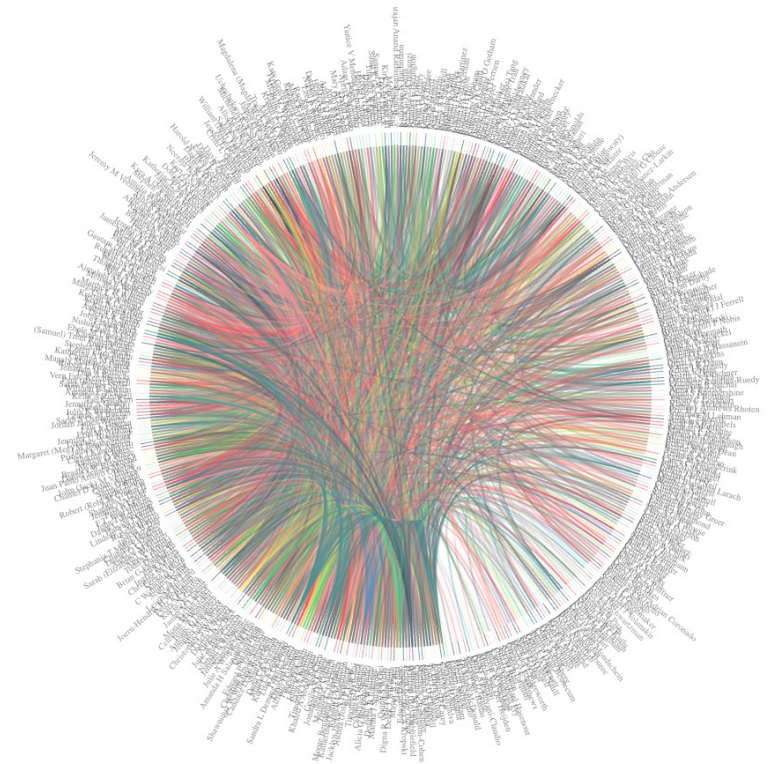
- One timeline with publications in blue dots, with journal names
- Another timeline with all grants in blue bars
- Similar to Scholar Profile



Group Publishing Collaborations



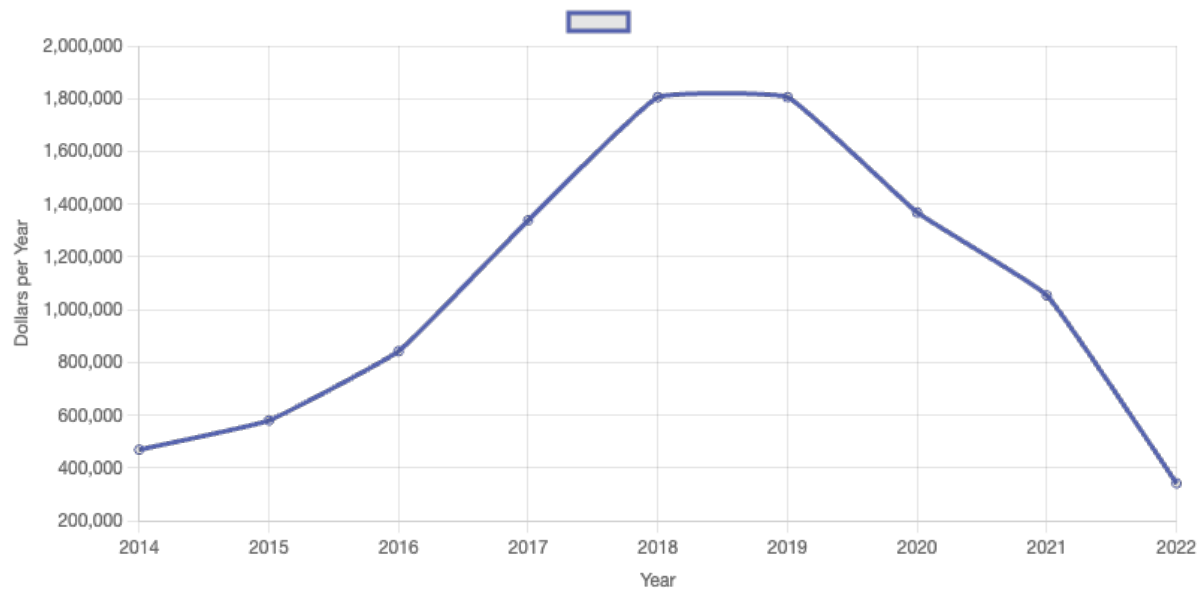
- Only data that accesses data for **entire Flight Tracker project**
- Co-authorships in Flight Tracker project
- Social network graph
- Note that it is “computationally expensive”



Grant Funding by Year



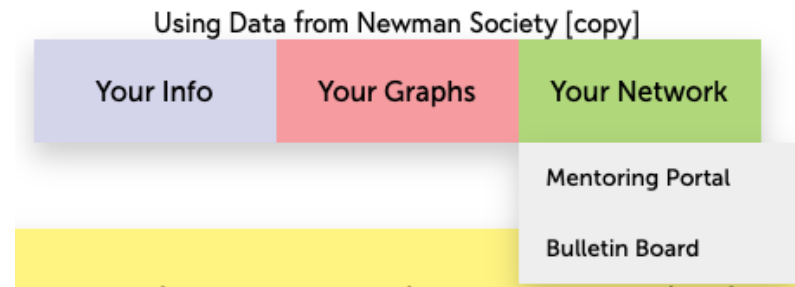
- Federal grant funding by year (total dollars)

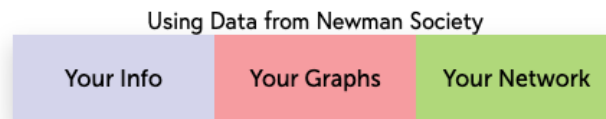

- In the General menu → Configure Application page
- **If you implement the Scholar Portal, we strongly recommend having an institutional “Bulletin Board Monitor” to patrol new messages.**
 - Add email address
 - Institutional role, not a project role
 - This person will receive **emails** with every new post
 - This person will have permission to **delete** posts, too
- The “Additional Institutional Resources” link is also on this page to set up a Resources link in the Scholar Portal


Access (Forthcoming)



- One link that is keyed off the REDCap login, accessing all projects
- Again, REDCap name-matching is used; this is inherently imprecise
- Link can be emailed out via **Scholars menu → Configure an Email**
- Link also available on Flight Tracker Home page (after **v6.0.0**)

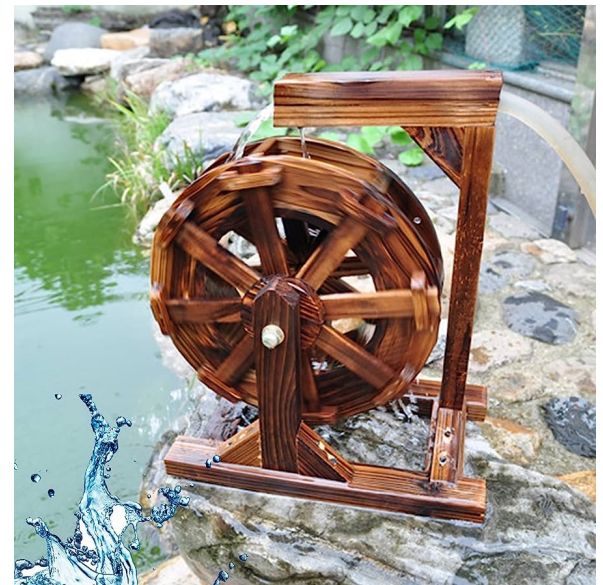

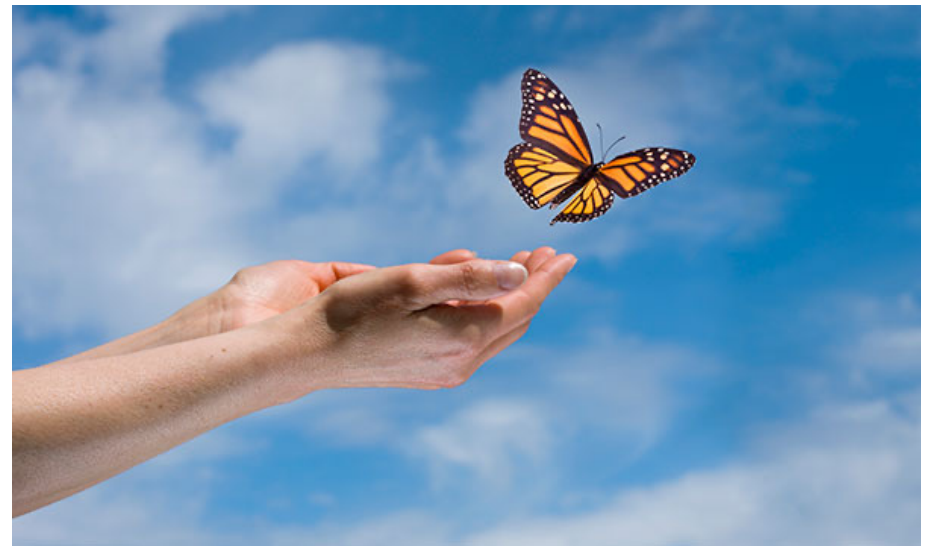
- Actively developing other tools to reach out to network

→ Custom build your own agreement first before filling out
- Ongoing work on validating survey & publishing process
- Refine Support for Individual Development Profiles



Relating Grants to Publications



- A lot of interest on desire to relate grants to publications
- Existing support:
 - PubMed tries to integrate but accuracy not 100%
 - View Publications page → Filter by Grants Cited
 - Public Access Compliance page
- Possibilities:
 - Type in a grant number and get all publications related to that grant
 - Supply a few grant numbers and associate these with grants
 - Use Scholar Portal as a resource for scholars to do this
- Sharda Osuna of USC led a spin-off committee with a list of recommendations

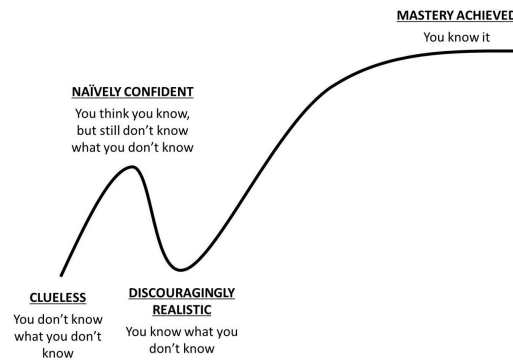
