
What's New?

Social Network of Collaborations



- In the next release [v6.22.0], the Social Network of Collaborations will have two revisions that allow you to group your scholars by either Person Roles or Cohorts
- Index by Field options:
 - Record ID [default]
 - Primary Department
 - Graduate Degrees
 - Current Division
 - [Any Person Roles]
 - Cohort
 - [Others...]





Raising Minimum Requirements



• In the next release [v6.22.0], Flight Tracker will increase its minimum requirements to:

• PHP version >= 7.4

• REDCap version >= 14.0.2

 By REDCap's records, no one will be incompatible for future updates

 Upgrading will enhance software security & developers' toolkit

• If you are incompatible, please contact me to troubleshoot

Publication Wrangling



- Main time-consumer in maintaining Flight Tracker data
- Two steps:
 - 1. Mass-approve longer, uncommon last names
 - 2. Look at non-approved scholars one by one our current discussion



Wrong Name Match

FLIGHT TRACKER for scholars

- Doppelgänger situation: Same name
 - E.g., Harold Moses & Harold Moses, Jr.
 - Check the middle initial
- Remedy: Uncheck the publication
 - When there are multiple author names, toggle all names at once via green button





Name "Explosion"



Flight Tracker "explodes" the names to include all available pubs:

• It searches all possible combinations of first names, nicknames,

last names & maiden names

- From a maiden name?
- From a nickname?
- From skipping over the middle name?
- Doppelgänger scenario applies to each, too



Wrong Name Match



Situation: It pulls in data from the wrong person

- Cause: Your institution matches another author
 - Check the PubMed abstract via the link to PubMed PMID: ######

Remedy: Uncheck the publication

- Situation: When you check out the PubMed abstract, your institution appears, but not with your person
- Remedy: Uncheck the publication

Missing Institution



- Situation: You're missing one of your scholar's institutions
 - Before they came to your place
 - After they left your place
- The Publication Wrangler has a list of institutions searched

16: Julie A Bastarache

Institutions Searched For: Vanderbilt University, Vanderbilt, Vanderbilt University Medical Center, Vanderbilt University School of Medicine, Meharry, Veterans Health Administration, and Tennessee Valley Healthcare System

 Remedy: Add a Position Change form in REDCap for that institution

Wrong ORCID Match



- Publications matched by ORCID are automatically accepted as wrangled
- Nightmare situation: You have a wrong ORCID! (i)



- Remedies:
 - Get the right ORCID in the ORCID Wrangler [Wrangle menu] and remove the bad ORCID
 - Reset the incorrectly matched publications [described later]

Initials in Author List



- Rare situation: Someone submitted a paper with a scholar's initials instead of their name
 - E.g., SJ Pearson instead of Scott J. Pearson
- PubMed will not return results for the full name
- Rare, but no good way to automatically fill
- Remedy: Manually add the PMID/PMCID [described later]

Publications Before 2014



- Situation: PubMed's data quality increased in 2014
- Before 2014, PubMed included affiliations only for first authors
- During and after 2014, PubMed included:
 - One affiliation for each author during 2014
 - Multiple affiliations for each author after 2014
 - [Only if supplied by the publisher]

Remedies:

- You can do a manual name search without institutions
- You may have to manually add PMIDs or PMCIDs



Tools to Fix Problems



- Reset publication
- Copy/paste PMIDs or PMCIDs
- Exclude lists
- Match without institutions [risky]



Reset Publication



- A publication's wrangling can be reset by clicking the tiny "reset" text on the Publication Wrangler then click "Finalize Pubs"
 - Then you'll have to check or uncheck it, like it's a new pub


Reset Publication



• Extra Hint: You can change the "Include?" field on its REDCap Citation form to blank [=unwrangled] or "No" [=omitted]



Current instance: #13 – 25730661 A randomized trial comparing didactics, demonstration, and simulation for teaching teamwork to medical residents | Select another + Add new



Copy & Paste PMIDs/PMCIDs





 You can enter one PMID or PMCID at a time

 Situation: You have a CV with several PMIDs or PMCIDs

Remedy:

- 1. Manually edit them into a list, one per line
- 2. Copy & paste the list into the Pub Wrangler to grab them all at once

Exclude Lists



- Situation: A scholar consistently matches the wrong person
 - Due to a bad name [e.g., Pearson SJ vs. Pearson AS]
 - Or from a different field [e.g., artificial intelligence]

Remedy:

- Add them to an "exclude list" at the top
- You can add more than one item via a comma
- Don't forget to click the Update button!

Match Without Institutions




Situation:

- You don't know if you have the institutions correct
- The name is fairly uncommon

Remedy:


- Go on that scholar's record in REDCap or Flight Tracker
- Buttons will appear above the menu
- Click the "Match Without Institutions: Publications" button
- This action is risky because you might get false matches

What's Next?

Find a Collaborator



- Earlier in 2024, the Scholar Portal added a way to search all Flight Trackers for a certain publication topic [MeSH term]
- We've been using it to focus emails for career opportunities, like a research grant for "Health Services Research"
 - Avoiding excess email noise
- We love the targeting; we want to improve it:
 - Make a more advanced interface
 - Make a table of outputs
 - Add it to the admin side of Flight Tracker, too
- In internal reviews
