# “Leaky Pipeline” Conversation



- **Focus:** How mentorship practices influence persisting in research & leaving research – *i.e.*, the “leaky pipeline”
- **Done:** We’ve developed a survey about mentorship practices
- **Doing:** We’re refining them currently through feedback
- **Doing:** We’re working on measurable outcomes to statistically relate those questions about mentorship
- **Will Do:** We want multiple sites to join our collection efforts for eventual publication

- As a limitation, they do **NOT** appear in REDCap Reports

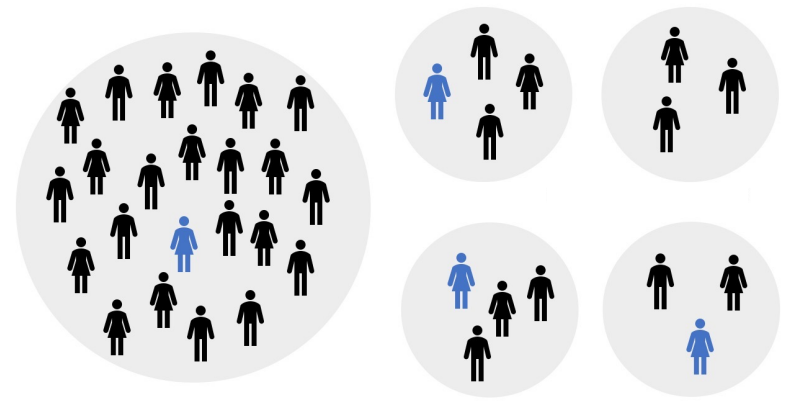

# Demographics



- Gender
- Race/Ethnicity
- Date of Birth
- US Citizenship Status
- Start of Training Program
- End of Training Program
- Tenure Status
- Academic Rank
- [More...]



# Grants



- Comparing internal funding vs. K12/KL2 recipients vs. externally funded Ks
- Different funding institutes
- Different activity codes
- Different conversion statuses
- Who started on K when [e.g., 2010-2015, 2016-2020]
- [Combinations of the above]

- Award Type [FT type]
- Activity Code [K23, R01, etc.]
- Institute/Center abbreviation
- K/R status



## Physician Scientists vs. PhDs



- Historic problem of MD vs. PhD silos – lack of collaboration
  - MD/PhDs as an attempt to overcome restriction
  - Yet many great breakthroughs have come from both sides interacting together!
- Depending on an organization's culture, different career outcomes can happen
  - Different career pathways
  - Different career pressures – funding & clinics
- MD only, MD + PhD, MD + other, PhDs, Other



## Departments & Divisions



- Highlighting collaborations between different fields
- Good for diagnosing how **interdisciplinary** your group is
  - Interdisciplinary papers tend to have higher impact factors
- Social Network of Collaborations – between cohorts



## Person Roles & Program Roles



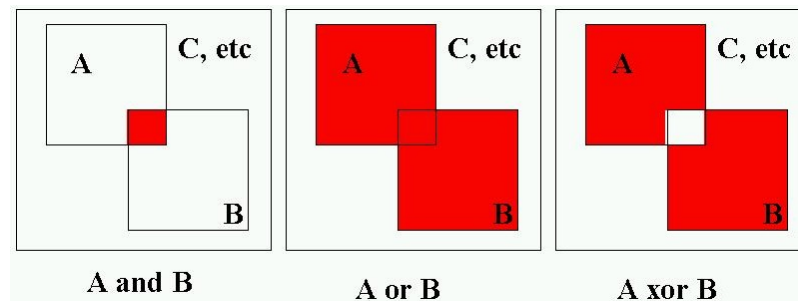
- You configure these items in the Application Configuration page
- They can be entered on the Identifiers form
  - Dropdown = person role [single-select]
  - Checkbox = program role [multi-select]
- *E.g.*,
  - Person role: Faculty, staff, student
  - Person role: Class of 2020, Class of 2021, ...
  - Program role: Mentor, PI, faculty, staff, student
- What do different subgroups look like in their profiles?



# Boolean Logic



- Precedence: XOR > AND > OR
  - XOR = Exclusive or – one or the other but not both
  - AND = one and the other
  - OR = one or the other or both

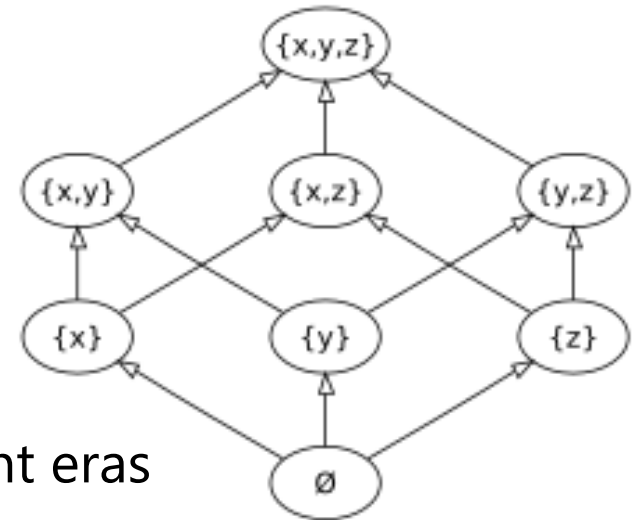


- Like in math, parentheses before times/divide before +/- similarly do XORs then ANDs then ORs

# Combinations with Boolean Logic



- You can create custom groups that combine more than one of these items → creative outcomes
- Up to 15 items in Flight Tracker
- *E.g.*, PhDs in Internal Medicine  
vs. MDs in Internal Medicine  
vs. MD/PhDs in Internal Medicine
- *E.g.*, people who received a grant in different eras  
[2010-2015 vs. 2016-2020 vs. 2021-2025]





# Hand-Picking a Cohort



- Quick, static groups – don't want to make a dynamic filter
- *Ad hoc* groups – no controlling factor
- Groups too complex for Boolean logic – more than 15 Boolean logic options

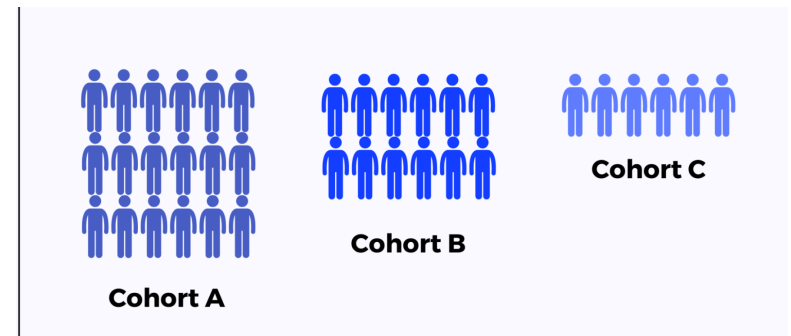

# What's Next?

## Mentee-Mentor Agreements v2.0



- MMAs help frame a mentoring relationship to head off potential problems
- Great for the new academic year with new mentors
- Mentors menu -> Start Mentee-Mentor Agreements
- **Problem:** But what about asking custom questions to mentees?
- **New:** Admins & mentors can add up to 5 custom questions if desired
- Almost done – Will be released likely within a week in **v6.23.0**



## A Broader Flight Tracker?



- The CRESP engineering group at Vanderbilt wants to extend Flight Tracker for engineering applications
- To do so, we hope to:
  - Support Web of Science [1<sup>st</sup> step]
  - Integrate with DOE & EPA grants?
  - Perhaps more...
- It'll be optional; it must be turned on
- WoS publications will be treated like PubMed publications
- **Development work just starting...**
